
Jesus Suffers and Dies for Us





Palm/Passion Sunday Matthew 21:1-11; 26:14-27:66

Reader 1: Jesus' friends put their cloaks over the animals. Jesus rode the donkey into the city of Jerusalem.

Reader 1: Jesus put water into a large bowl. He began to wash the feet of his friends. He dried their feet with a towel.

All: Why are you doing this, Jesus?

Jesus: You call me teacher and Lord, and that is who I am. I have washed your feet. You should do the same for one another.

All: We will follow your example, Jesus.

(Each child traces a cross on the next person's right shoe.)

Reader 2: Then Jesus took bread, said a prayer, broke the bread, and gave it to his friends.

Jesus: Take and eat. This is my body.

Leader: Then Jesus took a cup of wine, thanked


God for it, and gave it to his friends.

Jesus: This is my blood. It will be poured out for the forgiveness of sins.

Drink from it.


All: We will, Jesus.

Glue the photo of the priest acting like Jesus in this space.





Reader 1: After a while,


