

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# Jesus' Spirit is within us.



Our teacher's mother dies.








# **Directions to Make Your Well**


1. BEFORE you cut, fold all lines in both directions.





2. Cut slits only on the solid lines to create four flaps.

3. Fold the flaps around the center square.



4. Tape flaps.
